Patrons who find articles left in the seats are requested to leave them at the main entrance.

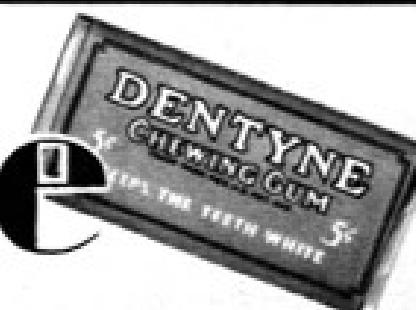
The management, seeking above all things to please its patrons, will gladly and thoroughly investigate any charges of discourtesy preferred against any of its employees.
